**Francesca Zappa** began playing the violin at the age of seven in her hometown of Florence. After high school she moved to Germany to continue her studies, first with Felix Schwarzt from the Berlin Staatskapelle and then with Ulrich Knoerzer and Wilfried Strehle of the Berliner

Philharmoniker. Other important impulses have been given in masterclasses by Nobuko Imai, Jürgen Kussmaul, Maxim Rysanov and Hartmut Rohde. He has performed with Deutsche Symphonie Orchester, Rundfunk Symphonie Orchester Berlin, Berliner Philharmoniker and Mitteldeutscher Rundfunk Leipzig. He has also participated in various chamber music festivals, such as Aurora Sweden, Encuentro Santander, Quartet Festival, Music in Barga in the Lucchesia, Moritzburg in Germany, Zermatt Festival, Schlossmediale Festival in Switzerland, L'Aura des Arts in France. Since 2015 he has been a scholarship holder of the Live Music Now association founded by Yehudi Menuhin. Francesca performed with the Scharoun Ensemble of the Berliner Philharmoniker at the Gewandhaus in Leipzig, in an evening dedicated to the music of Felix Mendelssohn.

Christophe Horak is a concertino of the second violins of the Berliner Philharmoniker. He studied at the Guildhall School of Music and Drama in London with maestro Yfrah Neaman; during his studies he received various awards, such as the "Max and Peggy Morgan Concerto Prize" and a scholarship from the Migros Cultural Foundation. In 2000 he entered the Karajan Academy of the Berliner Philharmoniker and two years later he won the place in the orchestra. He is a member of the Scharoun Ensemble, with which he has performed in Europe, America and Asia, and since 2009 he is a teacher at the Karajan Academy. He has worked as a shoulder violin with the Santa Cecilia Academy Orchestra. Christophe is a founding member of the Berlin Piano Quartet, with which in 2016 he recorded a CD for the SONY record company.

Cellist **Ulrike Hofmann** completed her musical training at the Universität der Künste (UDK) in Berlin with Prof. Markus Nyikos. Later he studied with Prof. Stanislav Apolin in Prague. As a salaried woman she attended two years of orchestra courses at the Karajan Academy of the Berliner Philmarmoniker. Winner of the "Deutsche Musikwettbeverb" competition, she was selected to take part in the "Konzerte Junger Künstler" festival, which began her solo career. He subsequently won the "Domenico Gabrielli" competition in Berlin and the Marktneukirchen International Competition and the Domnick "Violoncello Preis" Competition. She was First Cello Soloist at the Komische Oper in Berlin from 2003 to 2006. She is currently part of the "Stuttgart Radio Symphony Orchestra (SWR)". She is regularly invited to the "Chamber Orchester of Europe", the Ensemble Oriol of Berlin and to the Bremer Kammerphilarmonie.
